

GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

November 29, 2017

Administration Update

- Fundraising dollars from last year were set aside for a Makers Lab (a lego and robotics room that will be in one of the portables)
 - There was a delay due to A/C issues, but the plan is to get everything set up and have the room operational right after winter break
- 2017 funds are going to a new playground that will be located near the other covered awning in the back field
 - Mr. Aldridge is getting quotes on the equipment. Stone Lakes had a new playground installed last year and the price was just under \$30,000. He anticipates a similar price for us.
 - The goal is to install before the end of the school year so that all students that contributed to Boosterthon this year can enjoy the new playground

Givebacks

- "Specials" departments were given \$450 each to purchase needed equipment
 - P.E.: a TV
 - Music: drums and mallets
 - Art: easels and other art supplies
- Teachers were eligible for a \$50 grant from the PTO
 - Must be a PTO member and submit a receipt of purchased classroom supplies
 - o To date, there have been 26 grant requests and 5 receipts submitted

Boosterthon

- We received a profit of \$36,405 this year
 - Only 5 or 6 unpaid pledges
- A survey will be coming out in January to get feedback on Boosterthon and possible fundraising alternatives
- Making a switch to another fundraiser that does not raise \$35,000 would mean:
 - Teachers will no longer receive grants
 - There will be a charge for dances
 - Price will increase for the carnival
